Communications & Technology

The Communications committee helps oversee the internal and external communications and content shared by the organization while the Technology group works with our website, audio/visual and other tech needs.

Support needed includes: writers, graphic designers, marketers, communicators, social media, photographers video production, website development, SEO and creative ideas.

Membership
